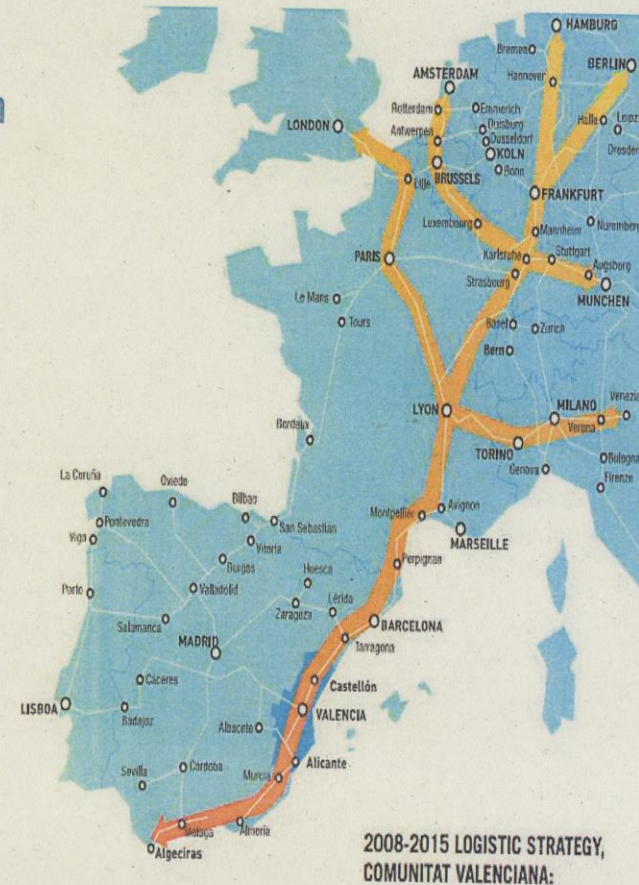

# JANVIER 2016: RAPPORT OXFAM-INTERMON

- 62 personnes possèdent en 2015 la même richesse que la moitié de la population mondiale. En 2010 ils étaient 388
- Depuis 2010 la “richesse “ des plus démunis a diminué en 1 billion (européen) de dollars (38%), tandis que la richesse des 62 personnes les plus riches du monde a augmenté en 500 milliards de dollars
- 7,6 billions (européens) de dollars dans les paradis fiscaux
- 30% du patrimoine financier d’Afrique se trouve dans des paradis fiscaux
- 9 associés, sur 10, de ceux qui assistent à la conférence de Davos sont présents dans un paradis fiscal au moins
- La différence entre bas et hauts salaires s’est accrue d’une façon alarmante

## History

Since inception in 1944, the World Bank has expanded from a single institution to a closely associated group of five development institutions. Our mission evolved from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) as facilitator of post-war reconstruction and development to the present-day mandate of worldwide poverty alleviation in close coordination with our affiliate, the International Development Association (<http://www.worldbank.org/ida/>), and other members of the World Bank Group, the International Finance Corporation (IFC) (<http://www.ifc.org/>), the Multilateral Guarantee Agency (MIGA) (<http://www.miga.org/>), and the International Centre for the Settlement of Investment Disputes (ICSID) (<http://icsid.worldbank.org/ICSID/Index.jsp>).

Once, we had a homogeneous staff of engineers and financial analysts, based solely in Washington, D.C. Today, we have a multidisciplinary and diverse staff that includes economists, public policy experts, sector experts and social scientists—and now more than a third of our staff is based in country offices.

Reconstruction remains an important part of our work. However, at today's World Bank, poverty reduction through an inclusive and sustainable globalization remains the overarching goal of our work.

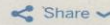

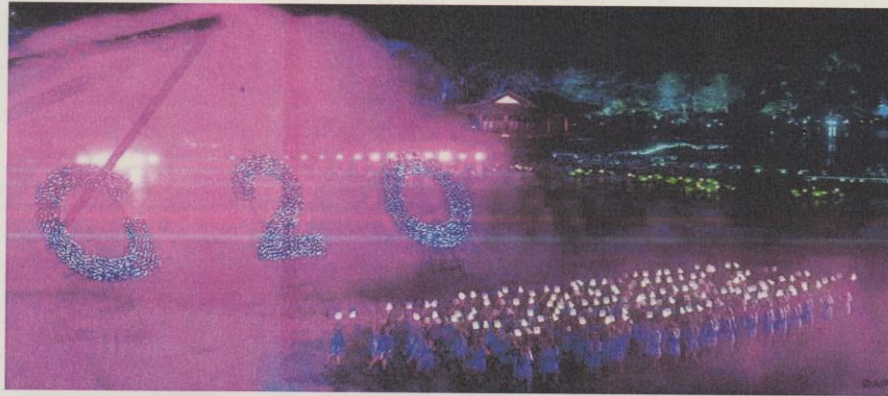

Even before the final communiqué is drafted for the annual G20 summit the leaders of the world's largest economies already seemed to agree on their most pressing priority: to find a way to sell the benefits of globalisation to an increasingly sceptical public.

As they arrived in the Chinese city of Hangzhou over the weekend, many were on the defensive amid a welter of familiar complaints back home: frustratingly slow growth, rising social inequality and the scourge of corporate tax avoidance.

"Many of our citizens are frustrated by the pace of globalisation and feel they are not experiencing the benefits of international trade," Theresa May, the British prime minister, said at a briefing just ahead of the summit's formal opening in Hangzhou in eastern China. "This is an issue we can't afford to ignore."

Mrs May was echoed by President Barack Obama of the US and his Chinese counterpart, Xi
