Social Economy in the EU: the political situation

- Council Conclusions on the Social Economy (2015) together with: EP resolutions, EESC opinions, CoR opinions;
- GECES report and recommendations (October 2016);
- "Start up and Scale-up" Initiative (October 2016);
- Series of actions coordinated by the launch of an **Internal Task Force** between different services (January 2017);
- Launch of a new Expert group in 2018 on "Social Economy and Social Enterprises" – More than 70 experts.



Presentation of the actions

1. Access to funding

EasI Programme (demand and supply side) – Structural Funds + Preparation of the new MFF (Invest EU /social window);

2. Access to markets

Social Public procurement – Increasing relations between traditional enterprises and social economy enterprises – Tackling cross borders issues;

3. Improving framework conditions

Mapping of social enterprises in Europe – The "Better entrepreneurship tool" – Education/training (ie: cooperatives entrepreneurship education project)



Presentation of the actions

4. Social innovation, technologies and new business models

Digitalisation and its impact on social economy (blockchain/ on line platform) - Promoting social innovation (Prize/Social innovation challenges platform)

5. International relations

Support to dedicated countries/regions – increased cooperation with international organizations (GSEF/UNTFSSE/OECD...)



Increasing the visibility of Social Economy: European Social Economy Regions Initiative



Awareness-raising and **better recognition** of social economy at regional and local level;

Gradual setting-up a **European social economy community**; **Identification of joint challenges** and preparing the ground for regional and inter-regional collaboration.
