ALS hosts the ROMANIAN MOUNTAIN COMMONS PROJECT

Unprecedented research - database including 329 surveyed cases of commons (20% of the existing 1 500 forest and pasture commons in the Romanian Carpathian Mountains and along the foothills,

873.000 ha of forest, 14% of the total forested surface of the country) accounting for nearly 1/2 of the forests and nearly 1/3 of the surface of pasture owned by the commons.
