Frequently Asked Questions - FAQ

In which language may I submit a communication?

Submissions are welcome in French, English or Spanish.

Submission guidelines are specified in the call for papers, available [here](#).

The abstract submission deadline is **March 29, 2026**.

A submission template can be downloaded [here](#).

When will I be notified of the acceptance of my submission?

Notification of acceptance will be sent no later than **May 29, 2026**, to the email address provided at the time of submission.

How can I register? Is there a reduced fee for academics?

The event website, including the registration module, will be launched shortly.

The registration fees are available [here](#).

A reduced fee will be available for members of the scientific community.

Is it possible to present an accepted paper online (live or pre-recorded format)?

No. The Congress is organized exclusively as an in-person event.

Will there be an option to attend the Congress (or part of it) virtually?

No virtual participation option will be offered.

What are the publication opportunities?

Selected papers may be submitted for publication in the *CIRIEC International Working Papers* or in *Économie et Solidarités*, the journal of CIRIEC-Canada.

Submission is not automatic and must be made directly to the relevant editorial bodies. All publications remain subject to their respective review and publication procedures.

May I publish my paper in another journal?

Yes. Authors retain full copyright of their work and are free to submit their paper to another journal.

Furthermore, submission of a full-length version of the paper will not be required as part of the Congress.



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Are there any scholarships or financial support to cover participation costs?

At this stage, no funding, scholarship or travel grant is available to cover registration or travel expenses.

My presentation does not appear in the general program. Where can I find it?

Papers selected through the Call for Papers will be scheduled in dedicated sessions integrated into the overall program.

These sessions will take place on Tuesday, 6 October, and Wednesday, 7 October (afternoon).

The detailed program and specific time slots will be communicated at a later stage.

Will I receive a certificate for presenting my paper?

Yes. A certificate of participation/presentation will be issued to presenters who are registered for the Congress.

It will be sent by email after the event.
